



SELECTION RESULTS FOR DIGITRAINING PROGRAMME

Brussels, Belgium, June 30th, 2021.

The beneficiaries for **DigiTraining, Digital & Audiovisual Capacity Building for Accessible Heritage**, a project co-funded by the European Commission under the Creative Europe Programme have been selected. 84 beneficiaries were accepted to take part in the **General Programme**. Among them 6 organisations will be provided with tailor-made mentoring through the **Specific Programme** and 3 will benefit from the production and application of Advanced Technology through the **Qualified Programme**.

The beneficiaries of the DigiTraining activities were selected by a committee appointed by the Partners, including members of its own qualified teams. The selection process was done transparently, taking into account the objectives of DigiTraining, as well as its resources, the declared needs of the potential beneficiaries, and the quality of the information provided in their proposals. The selected beneficiaries were informed of the outcome, and the unsuccessful applicants received a motivated communication on the outcome of the process and its result.
